On behalf of the Greenpoint Williamsburg Waterfront Task Force we are writing to express our sincere appreciation for Judge Lynch and DPS Staff appearing on December 13, 2001 in Greenpoint at the process forum regarding the TransGas Energy LLC ("TransGas") proposal to construct an 1,100 megawatt power plant on the East River waterfront.

The community is obviously very concerned about this project and unified its opposition because a power plant in this location will jeopardize future residential and commercial waterfront development proposed for the area. While the process forum became heated as the community expressed its genuine and understandable frustration at having to squander its limited resources for legal counsel and experts to stop this proposal we believe Judge Lynch, DPS Staff, NYSERDA Staff and DEC staff handled the situation excellently.

We respectfully request DPS and DEC to hold another process forum for the Williamsburg community. As you are aware the proposed project straddles both the Williamsburg and the Greenpoint communities. These communities have distinct interests and population. So far, TGE's Open House and TGE's Town Hall Meeting were held in Greenpoint; DPS/DEC Process Forum was also held in the Greenpoint area. In addition, a number of people could not participate in the process forum because the 400-person room filled quickly.
