

Manhattan Ave Street End Park
DDC is currently in the design phase for a new street end park at the end of Manhattan Ave.

Expansion of Barge Park Playground
The Department of Parks and Recreation has formally requested the transfer of Lot 32, owned by the City of New York, to the Parks Department for the expansion of the playground.

Sludge Tank Adaptive Reuse Project
A study is underway for the adaptive reuse of the sludge tank for a community use facility. The lower level could be tied into the expanded Park

Greenpoint Lumber Exchange
Recently optioned to a residential developer. Approximately 24 acres of space for development. Would require waterfront open space per NYC Waterfront Zoning Regulations

REZONING AREA
The Department of City Planning is currently actively working on upzoning the properties within this area. They intend to have recommendations early in 2003 and immediately begin the ULURP and EIS process

EDC Pier/Promenade Project
The NYC Economic Development Corporation has secured design funding and partial construction funding for an esplanade between Kent and Java Streets, including a recreational pier

WNYC Park
This site is owned by the City of New York and controlled by the Department of Parks and Recreation. Design funding was recently granted for planning a public park on the site.

Greenpoint Terminal Market
The site is owned by a residential developer currently in the process of preparing designs for the 14 acre site. The project will include a public waterfront promenade per NYC Waterfront Zoning Regulations

Site of the building of the Civil War Ironclad "Monitor"
While the community had hopes for this as a National Park Service Site, it has been sold to the owners of B&H Photo

Bushwick Creek Inlet
Currently on the short list for NY State Open Space Acquisition Listing

Proposed TGE Power Plant Project
1,100 megawatt gas-fired powerplant being opposed by the community

Owner plans residential development

NYU Facility
