

GWAPP Community Meeting on Rezoning

QUESTIONNAIRE RESULTS

The following are the results of a questionnaire distributed during the 6/29/04 GWAPP quarterly meeting where the Community Board 1 Rezoning Task Force responses to the rezoning of Greenpoint proposed by the NYC Department of City Planning were presented. This meeting is part of a series to be hosted throughout Greenpoint and Williamsburg by the North Brooklyn Alliance- a coalition of community groups formed to inform and educate the neighborhood on the community alternatives to the rezoning plan proposed by the City. Presentations were made on the (4) committee subjects of the Task Force and the rezoning: Economic Development, Affordable Housing, Height and Bulk and Parks and Open Space.

There were 130 in attendance. 100 completed questionnaire's.

RESULTS:
